CONSTRUCTION DETOUR STATE ROUTE 180/KINGS CANYON ROAD BETWEEN TEMPERANCE & ACADEMY

WHAT: 4-lanes of New Expressway will be constructed and Kings Canyon will have a traffic DETOUR in place on SR-180/Kings Canyon Road between Temperance and Academy Avenues to construct the NEW roadway. A posted DETOUR will be in place directing motorists traveling on SR-180/Kings Canyon Road to take Belmont Avenue, between Temperance and Academy Avenues during Phase 1 or to take Jensen Avenue, between Temperance and Academy Avenues during Phase 2.

DETOUR: PHASE 1 – CONSTRUCT WEST BOUND LANES OF FUTURE EXPRESSWAY

All crossroads accessing Kings Canyon Road from the NORTH will be **CLOSED**. Traffic will be **DETOURED** on to Belmont Ave., using Temperance, McCall or Academy*.

PHASE 2 – CONSTRUCT EAST BOUND LANES OF FUTURE EXPRESSWAY

All crossroads accessing Kings Canyon Road from the SOUTH will be **CLOSED**. Traffic will be **DETOURED** on to Jensen Ave., using Temperance, McCall or Academy*.

*(McCall & Academy will be CLOSED periodically during the construction.)

QUESTIONS: The Fresno County Transportation Authority, (FCTA) in partnership with the Department of Transportation, (Caltrans) reminds motorists to "Slow for the Cone Zone" and thanks the residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during this construction project. This \$27 million transportation project is locally funded through our "Measure C", ½ cent

sales tax program and was leveraged with Federal Stimulus money and is SCHEDULED FOR COMPLETION Summer of 2011 weather permitting.
