State Route 180 Construction Update: **2-month CLOSURE of Academy Avenue**

WHAT: Academy Avenue will be CLOSED to northbound traffic at the intersection of Kings Canyon Road/SR-180 to construct NEW roadway lanes. A DETOUR will be provided to motorists. Academy Avenue will be OPEN south of SR-180 to motorists.

In addition, starting September 8, McCall Avenue will RE-OPEN to motorists with intermittent 5-minute delays for a 2-week truck-hauling operation. CHP is enforcing 25 MPH posted speed limit through the Construction Zone.

WHEN: Wednesday, September 8—through mid-November
(Weather permitting)

DETOUR: All motorists are advised to use Belmont or Jensen Avenues to avoid the Construction Zone and use Temperance or McCall Avenues to travel north or southbound from SR-180.

SCHEDULE: This \$27 million project is locally funded by Fresno County's ½ cent Transportation Sales Tax, "Measure C" & was leveraged with Federal Stimulus Money. It is scheduled for completion in the Summer of 2011, weather permitting
