### **TEMPERANCE AVE. RE-OPENS WITH A 4-WAY STOP AT KINGS CANYON RD. STATE ROUTE 180 EAST CONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

**WHAT:** Temperance Avenue will Re-open with a 4-Way Stop at the intersection of Kings Canyon Road (SR-180). It will be in effect Friday as of 5 p.m. Changeable message signs will alert motorists on SR-180 of the new 4-Way Stop.

**When:** Friday, July 18 by 5:00 p.m.

**WHY:** The 4-Way Stop is in place to ensure the safety of the motoring public as part of the construction project of State Route 180 East. A permanent signal light will replace the 4-Way Stop prior to the Freeway opening in 2010.

**WHERE:** State Route 180 East Construction Project Limits; Clovis Avenue to Locan Avenue in Fresno County.

The Fresno County Transportation Authority, (FCTA) in partnership with the Department of Transportation, (Caltrans) reminds motorists to Slow for the Cone Zone and thanks the residents, businesses and commuters for their patience during this 2 ½-year locally funded Measure "C" construction project.
